Since October 2017, The Pontefract Academies Trust Attendance Policy changed to include fining parents. It is the Wakefield Local Authority that issues the fines and the money goes to the authority and not to our school.

If a school can improve attendance by 1%, they will see a 5-6% improvement in attainment. (Department for Education and Skills) Please help your child and us by ensuring their attendance remains above 96%, allowing them to achieve their potential.
