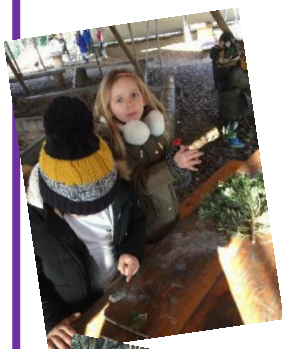

Message from the School Council

Dear Parents,

As you know at the Rookeries we take the safety of our children very seriously but this requires the responsibility of the whole school community. This involves the help of parents, children and teachers.

Parking is not permitted on the yellow lines outside of school under any circumstances.

Parking on these yellow lines blocks access to the school, which is required by taxis and mini buses that collect and drop of our hearing impaired children or children with disabilities.

Parking on the markings outside of school endangers the lives of children leaving school and trying to cross the road. Parking on the pavements also stop adults and children from walking safely to and from school.

We do not want to see any of our children getting injured or worse from cars parking without any care for others. The yellow lines in front of school and entrances to car parks and drop off points, should be kept clear at all times.

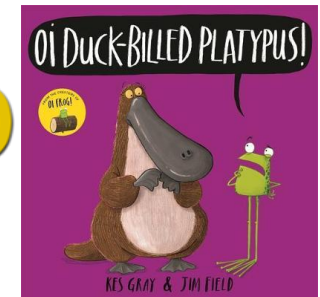
