Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to provide you with an end of year report that provides you with a detailed summary of the achievements and progress your child has made this year.

As you can imagine, it has been a challenging academic year interrupted by the lockdown procedures. I fully understand the potential impact this may have had on children's academic and personal progress, but rest assured we will provide the necessary intervention and curriculum model in September to facilitate 'catch up' in all subjects. Information about attendance and behaviour has been simplified into a PRAG (purple, red, amber, green) rated table. There is a simple explanation included in each table that tells you what each colour means. I hope you find this useful. Attendance and behaviour summaries are really important indicators for parents/carers to know. It goes without saying that the more a child can be in class in front of their teacher, the more likely it is they will fully realise the potential they possess. Good behaviour further supports their academic and personal achievements.

I must stress that any data we have provided you with is a reflection of progress made from the beginning of the academic year until March 2020 **only**. I understand that children will have naturally made further progress in school towards their target grades and strengthened their knowledge and understanding in key subject areas, had they been in full time education. This report is designed to let you know where they were on that learning journey until the period of lockdown began.

Equally important to all staff and parents/carers is the personal development and wellbeing of your child. The personal statement made at the beginning of the report, and the section on 'reasons to be proud of your child', will give you a flavour of the wonderful aspects of their character we have had the pleasure to witness this academic year. You should be proud of their achievements, as I certainly am. Every child made progress this year. We will be unwavering in our commitment to consolidate learning, develop character and take care of every aspect of your child's development in the new academic year.
