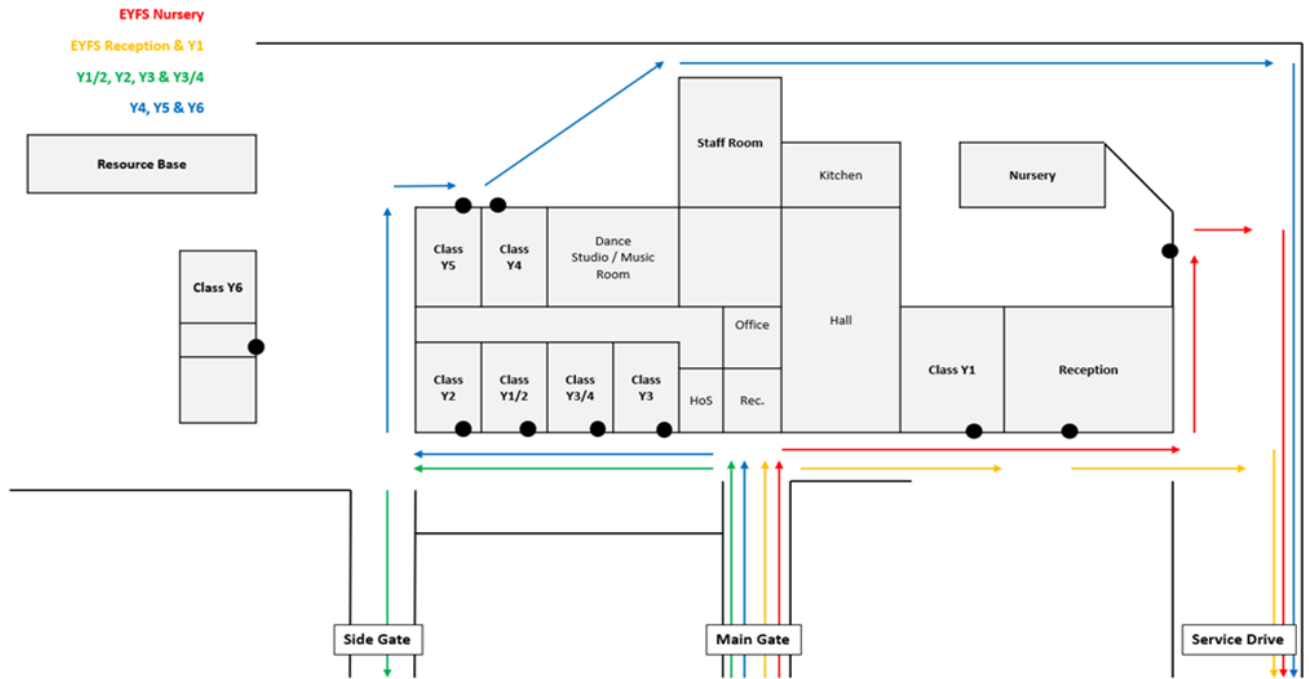
I hope that everyone has a lovely weekend, and I look forward to seeing you all on Monday morning.
