**Visit to Temple Newsam – Wednesday 14th June 2023 – Year 1**

On Wednesday 14th June 2023 we will be taking Year 1 children on a visit to Temple Newsam House & Farm.

The day supports our History curriculum work and our class book 'The Lion and the Unicorn'. The children will take a trip back in time to learn about the gripping events during the Great Fire of London. They will discover the 300 year old fire engine and feel the weight of the metal fire buckets. They will get the chance to dress up as Charles II and tour the house looking for clues about life at that time. Children will also visit the farm.

The cost of this trip is £16.00. This includes entry to Temple Newsam, the Fire of London workshop, entry to the farm and coach travel to and from school. Children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding will receive a 50% discount, please select the PP option on MCAS for £8.00. The trip must be paid for via MCAS.

The coach will leave school at 9:30am and return to school for the end of the day.

Children do not have to wear school uniform. Please send them in sensible shoes for walking and a waterproof coat.
